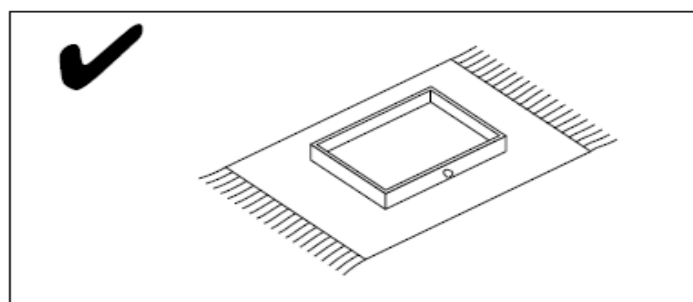
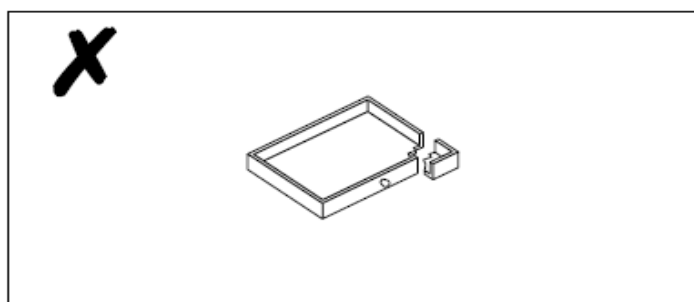
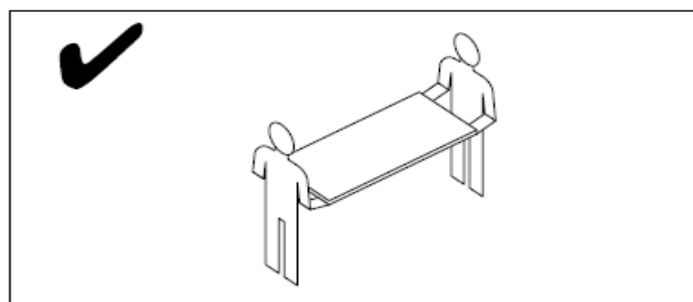
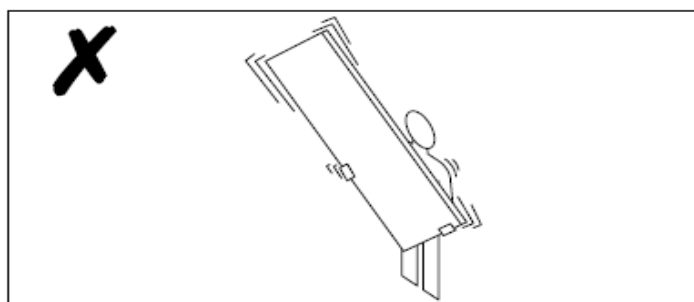
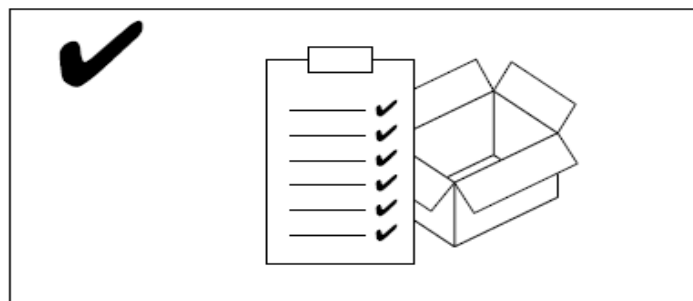
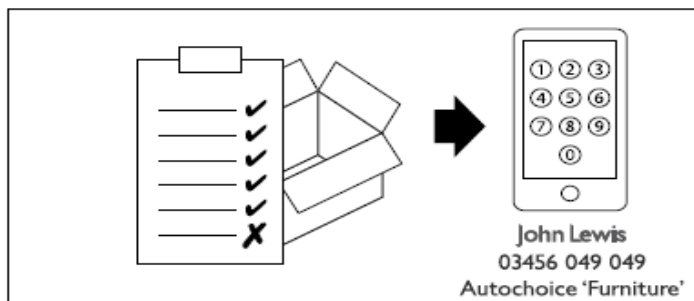
- △The product should only be used on firm, level ground.
- △Keep small parts out of reach of children.
- △Ensure the product is fully assembled as illustrated before use.
- △Parasol should not be used in high winds or during inclement weather.
- △This parasol must always be weighted with a suitable base weighing a minimum of 60kg, even when closed.
- △When not in use close parasol canopy and use a parasol cover.
- △Store away when cold wet and windy weather conditions.

## Do

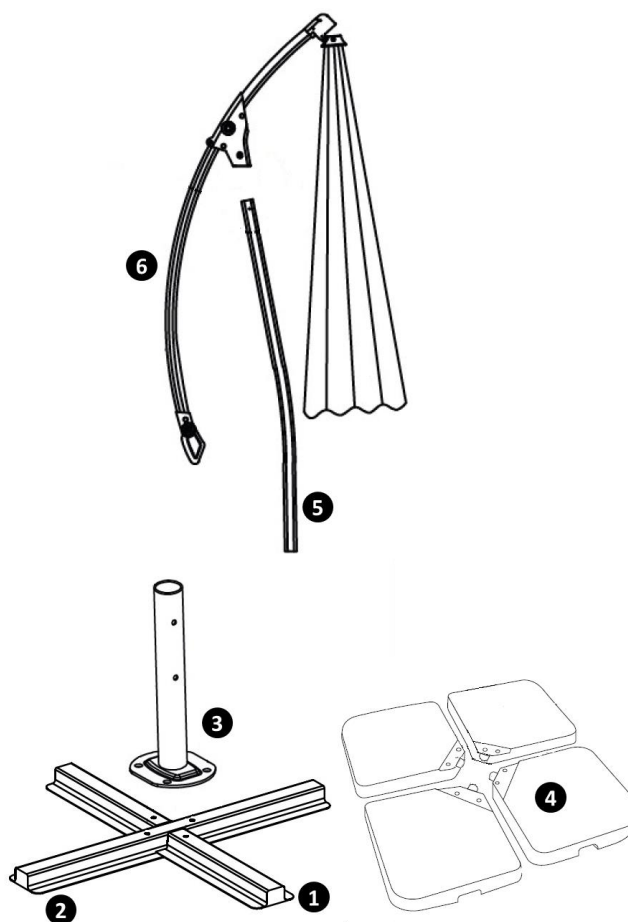
- ✓ Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed.
- ✓ Check all screws or bolts are tightened and inspect regularly.
- ✓ Make sure the cross base remains in contact with the ground at all times.

## Don't

- ✗ Do not over tighten the bolts, screws or crank.
- ✗ Do not stand on the product.
- ✗ Do not use power tools to construct as overtightening may occur.

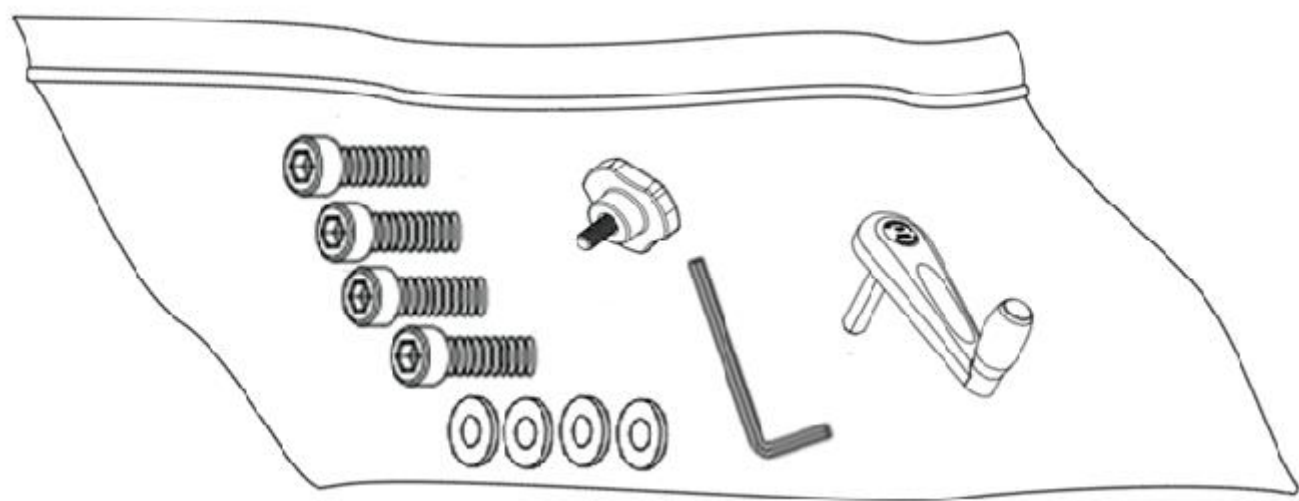

# Product assembly

Free Standing Parasol 3M with Base

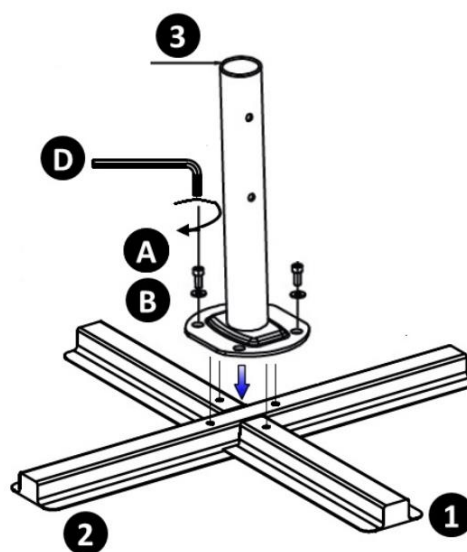

## Step 1

Parts, fittings, and tools

1 2 3 A B D

Attach lower pole (3), cross base section (1), cross base section (2) with bolts and washers (A,B) using allen key (D). Ensure all bolts (A) are fully tightened but not over tight.



## Step 2

Parts, fittings, and tools

4

Fill the base with water, sand or both. Sand is heavier than water and would recommend using sand.



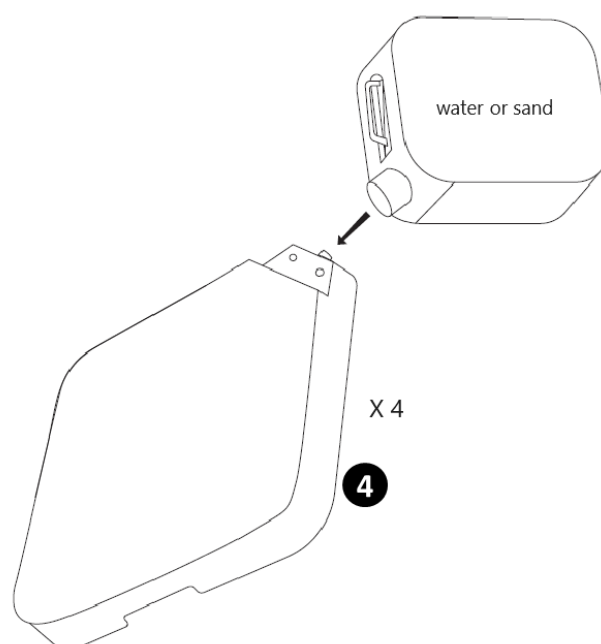
Warnings:

Never leave water in base when freezing conditions this will damage base.

Don't stand or jump on base.

If windy we recommend taking umbrella down to avoid tipping and ribs snapping.

When filled with water or sand base is heavy, avoid moving and dropping.

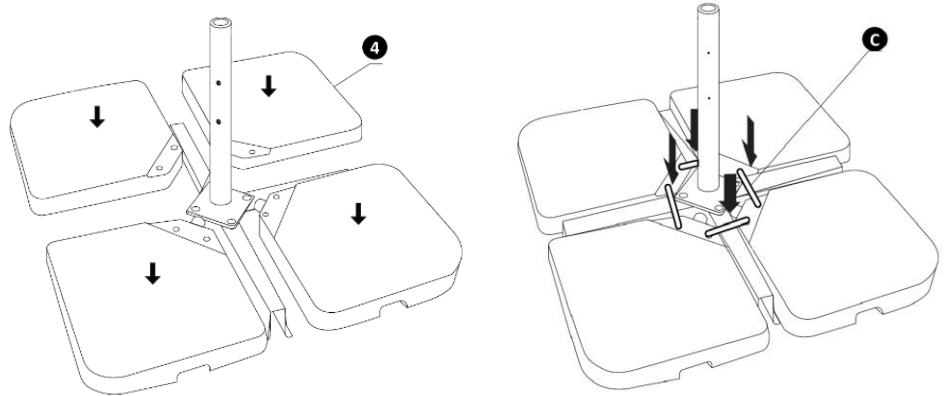


## Step 3

Parts, fittings, and tools

**4 C**

Place fillable base (4) on top of the assembled cross base section, Secure this in place with U hook(C).

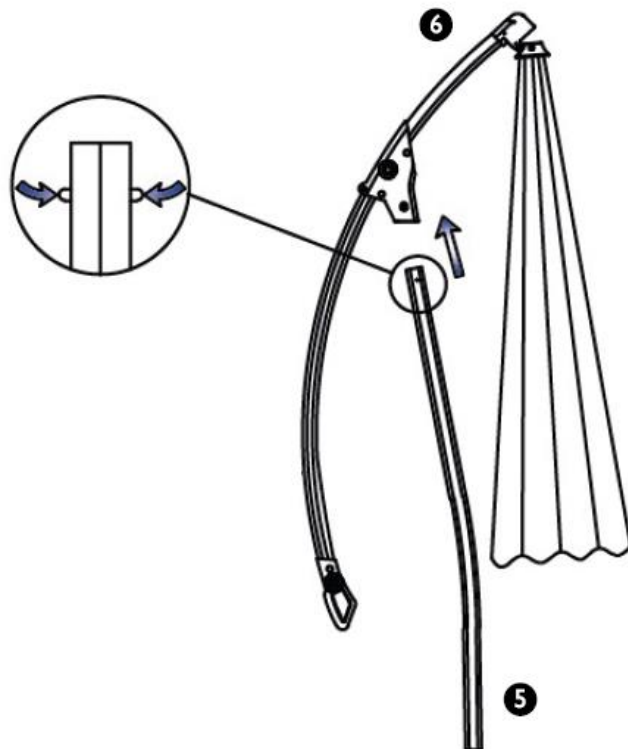


## Step 4

Parts, fittings, and tools

**5 6**

Attach the pole (5) to the parasol (6) by pressing in the buttons on either side and inserting into the mechanism on the support pole.

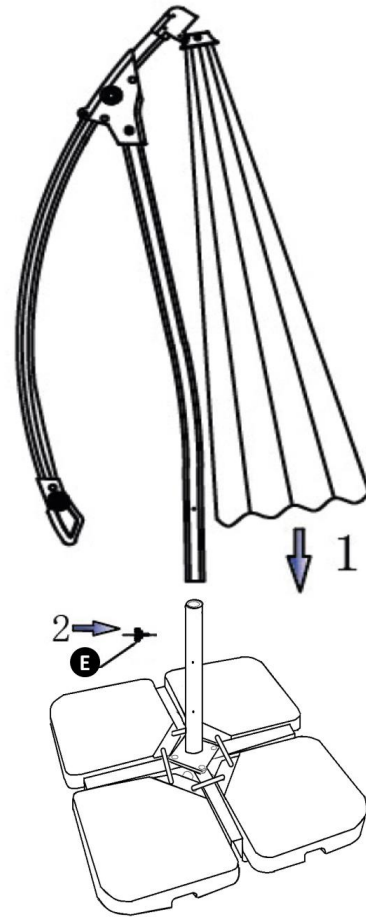


## Step 5

Parts, fittings, and tools

**E**

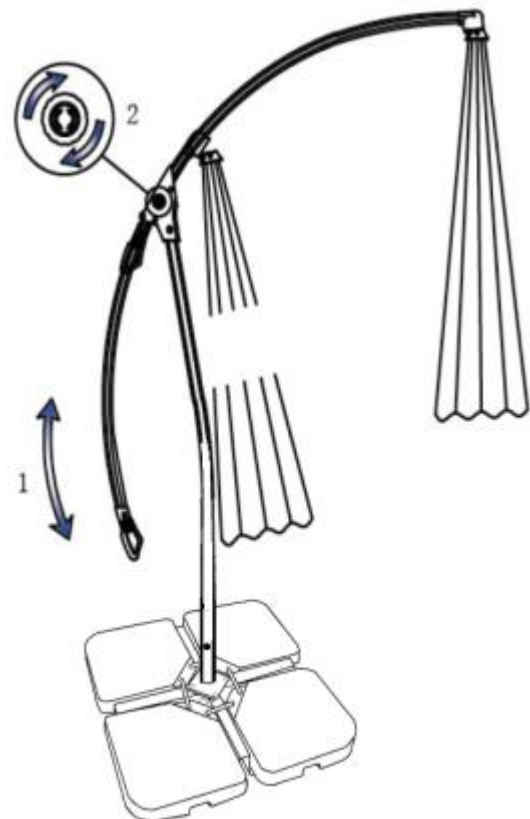
Insert the pole of the parasol (5) into the lower pole (3) and insert securing screw (E) into the lower pole (3).



## Step 6

Parts, fittings, and tools

To use the parasol, push the support pole of the parasol (6) in an upward motion and secure into place by turning the mechanism in a clockwise direction.





## Step 7

Parts, fittings, and tools

**F**

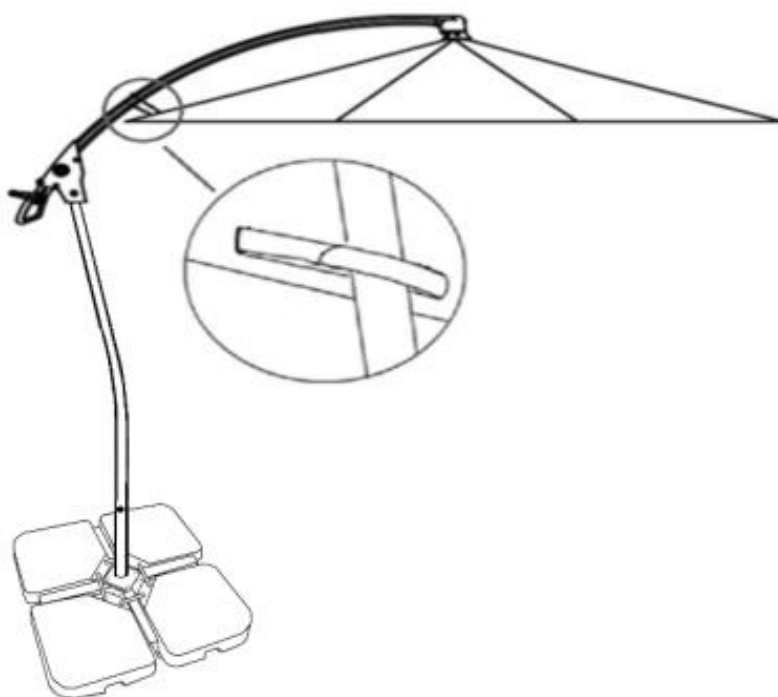
Insert the crank handle (F) into the pole on the parasol (6). To open the parasol (6), turn the crank handle (F) in a clockwise direction. To close the parasol (6), turn the crank handle (F) in an anti-clockwise direction.



## Step 8

Parts, fittings, and tools

To reduce movement when the canopy is open, fasten the canopy strap around the frame. Always unfasten canopy strap before taking the canopy down. Parasol cover is not included although recommended when parasol is down.



## Care guide

### Care and maintenance

This product is made from powder coated steel/aluminium and polyester; it is suitable for outdoor use. Do not overtighten the crank as this can damage the mechanism. To extend the product life and appearance it is recommended to store the parasol in a cool dry, well-ventilated place such as a garage or shed over winter or during periods of unseasonal weather. Ensure that the parasol is clean and completely dry before putting into storage. Do not enclose the product in a plastic or other non-permeable material as this promotes rust and mould. Cover it with a dust sheet or furniture cover allowing the air to circulate around it. We recommend that you clean your parasol at the beginning and end of the season. To clean the parasol remove all dirt using mild soap and water. Never use abrasive chemicals or cleaning agents. Rinse thoroughly and allow to dry. Bird droppings and tree sap should be cleaned off immediately.

### Safety instructions

This parasol has been designed for domestic use only. Parasol can be dangerous if incorrectly assembled, it should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly assembled parasols.

Parasols should not be used in high winds or during inclement weather.

This parasol must always be weighted with a suitable base, even when closed.

When not in use, the parasol canopy should be closed and covered with a parasol cover.

Never drag a parasol when moving it, always lift it.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.

Please take care when handling or moving the parasol as careless handling may cause damage or injury.

Ensure that the parasol is always on a solid and level surface at all times.

With all parasols, please exercise care when folding, unfolding, and adjusting positions to avoid any possibility of pinched or trapped fingers.

Please do not excessively tilt or sway this canopy. Please do not hang items from or swing from the canopy as this will cause tipping.

Retain these instructions for future reference.
