

Getting started





1. Secure bracket (F) to the wall with plastic bolts (D) and long screws (C).

NOTE: Requires a Phillips screwdriver to tighten the screws



2. Make electrical connections on terminal block as shown. Connect supply live (normally brown or red color) to fitting live (marked "L") on the terminal block. Connect supply neutral (normally blue or black color) to fitting neutral (marked "N") on the terminal block. Ensure electrical connections are tight and no loose strands of wire are left out of the connector block. Place terminal block into canopy.

NOTE: Requires a slotted head screwdriver to tighten the wire.



3. Place the canopy of the lamp body (A) over the bracket (F). Secure lamp body (A) to the bracket (F) by placing the short screws (E) into the holes on the side of lamp body (A) and tighten each screw with a screwdriver (not included).

NOTE: Requires a Phillips screwdriver to tighten the screws.

4. Socket ring (G) comes pre-assembled to the socket (A). Before placing the shade (B) onto the socket (A), please unscrew this socket ring (G). Then place shade (B) onto the socket (A) and screw on socket ring (G) clockwise on socket (A) until tight to secure the shade (B).
