


- 1m Bambino TiiPii Bed -

Each and every TiiPii Bed is made using the highest quality materials and is finely crafted to provide great enjoyment and relaxation for many years to come. Please read these instructions carefully. Proper maintenance and care will help to prolong the life of the TiiPii and reduce the potential for injury, product damage or voided warranty.

So, what is it that you'll find inside...?

- Minimum space required - to hang your TiiPii



For safety reasons, please do not hang the Bambino TiiPii more than 30cm above ground for children or 50cm above the ground for adults.

Minimum floor space: Ø 1.5m

-Please retain this important information for future reference-

When using the Bambino TiiPii Bed as a free hanging bed or from an alternate structure, the load limit is 100kgs / 220lbs.

If pairing the Bambino TiiPii Stand (sold separately) with the TiiPii Bed, the maximum load limit is 70kgs / 110lbs. Any weight over this will cause the TiiPii Bed to ground on the floor.

**A Bambino Stand should NEVER be used without the stabiliser sand bag –
this is an important safety measure to prevent the TiiPii & Stand from
potentially tipping over and causing injury**



- Assembling your TiiPii -

- 1. Remove the TiiPii base, five aluminium ring sections & canopy net from the carry bag
- 2. Fully open the fabric TiiPii base and place it on the ground, with the suspension ropes resting on the underside of the base, and the zipper side on top. Open the semi-circular zipper section of the base.
- 3. Make sure there's sufficient hanging space to freely hang the TiiPii Bed if using without the TiiPii Stand (Refer to measurements on Page 1)
- 4. Start by feeding the ring sections, one by one and all in the same direction, through the opening located on one side of the TiiPii Bed base. *FYI, it helps to have someone on the opposite side of the TiiPii, assisting to shuffle the ring sections around smoothly as they are fed through the sleeve.
- 5. Each ring section must be connected 'male' to 'female'. The male end of each ring section will lock itself into the female end of the previous section.
- 6. Feed three of the ring sections through the fabric TiiPii base to form a semi-circle within the sleeve. After this, keep adjoining the remaining ring sections together to form a full circle these sections will not be concealed within the fabric base yet.
- 7. When the ring sections have been fully assembled to form a solid circular ring piece, slip the other half of the fabric TiiPii base around the remaining ring sections & zip closed.
- 8. Hold the TiiPii by the top of the hanging point of the suspension ropes to double check that ropes are not twisted or looped underneath each other. Check that the base of the bed looks evenly connected.
- 9. Ensure that the desired hanging area is free from unwanted objects, sharp items, flames and obstructions of all kinds.
- 10. If using an alternative stand or structure other than the Bambino TiiPii Stand, it is imperative that the desired hanging apparatus is safe and able to support the maximum load limit specified for the TiiPii Bed of 100kg. *It is entirely the responsibility of the user or guardian to test the hanging structure well prior to use and to ensure that the TiiPii is adequately supported.
- 11. Once the TiiPii is securely hung, attach the ambient canopy net by fastening the Velcro tabs just below the top loop at the top of the TiiPii if desired.
- 12. The ambient canopy net can also be tied to the suspension ropes via the internal strings to secure it in place, or leave it loose to allow more breeze to filter through.
- 13. If required, use the tether points positioned on the side of the TiiPii to fasten or tether the TiiPii down when necessary. This is highly recommended when in use by children & in moderate to high winds.



-TiiPii Safety-

Please read & complete these safety checks every time before use to avoid hazard and / or injury:

- 1. The Bambino TiiPii Bed is not intended for use by children under the age of 3 years. Infants or young children under the age of 3 are never to be placed inside the TiiPii Bed at any time.
- 2. Children are to be under direct adult supervision at all times whilst using the TiiPii Bed.
- 3. Never leave a child unattended. Do not allow to stand, swing, bounce or jump inside the TiiPii; it is not to be used as a trampoline or a toy.
- 4. Always check that the overall structure, suspension ropes and ring system are in good order, without any deformation.
- 5. Do not use if there are obvious signs of damage that could impair strength or usability.
- 6. Smoking and naked flames forbidden. Never to be used in the vicinity of flames or direct heat of any kind (candles, cigarettes, fireplaces, campfires, BBQ's, radiators, etc)
- 7. Never allow water to gather in the base of the TiiPii Bed failure to do so could provide a risk of children drowning.
- 8. Ensure that the position of the TiiPii is sufficiently clear of walls, sharp objects and unwanted obstructions from either side, above and below the TiiPii.
- 9. Do not allow the suspension ropes to become twisted or intertwined at any time. Do not rotate the TiiPii or wind up the ropes to spin the TiiPii around as this could cause injury.
- 10. If pairing the TiiPii with the Bambino Stand (sold separately), fill the stabiliser sand bag (included with Stand) entirely with sand & place on the base of the Stand to weight it down & prevent tipping. *This is an extremely important safety measure to avoid injury. Check that there is no movement or ability to unbalance before each use. Always use Stand on an even ground. Refer to the 'Bambino Stand Safety & Maintenance Checks' before use.
- 11. Never hang the base of the TiiPii Bed more than 30cm above ground for children.
- 12. Always ensure that if any alternate structure or hanging point is used to support the TiiPii Bed it is strong, without defects and structurally adequate to bear the intended maximum load limit of 100kgs / 220lbs at all times without compromise. This is solely the responsibility of the guardian to ensure, and failure to do so could result in serious injury.
- 13. Ensure all knots tied and / or hanging attachments used are sufficiently able to bear the intended maximum load of 100kgs / 220lbs.
- *Note If the TiiPii Bed is paired with the Bambino TiiPii Stand, the maximum load limit is 70kgs / 155lbs.



-How to safely enjoy a TiiPii-

Keep both feet on the ground and enter or exit from your TiiPii in a gentle, smooth motion. We advise to slowly sit, bottom first like you would a chair, and shuffle your way into your TiiPii. Do not jump, dive or step in as this could cause damage or injury.

Never climb in one foot at a time. Please do not jump or stand inside the TiiPii with sudden movements.

Ensure you can easily step out from the TiiPii onto solid ground, placing feet out first and holding onto the suspension ropes or ring system for added balance and support as required.

The incline of the TiiPii will change depending on where the most weight is centered. Use the harness loops on the base of the (3 points) to anchor and tie down the TiiPii into a fixed position if required. This will stop the base from swaying and tilting into positions whilst there is movement inside. This is highly recommended when in use by children and in strong winds.

If pairing with the Bambino Stand (sold separately), do not attempt to setup or use the Stand on a sloping, uneven or soft ground as the Stand may become unbalanced, resulting in injury.

It is imperative when using the Bambino Stand to use it every single time with the stabiliser sand bag. Fill the stabiliser sand bag (included with Stand) entirely with sand & place on the base of the Stand to weight it down & prevent tipping. *This is an extremely important safety measure to avoid injury. Check that there is no movement or ability to unbalance before each use. Never use the Stand without the stabiliser bag under any circumstance

Children are to be supervised at all times. Not intended for children under the age of 3.

Never exceed the load limitation of 100kgs / 220lbs.

- Care and cleaning - instructions...

Rest assured we are absolute sticklers for quality. We want you to be able to enjoy your TiiPii Bed for many years to come - and if you follow our simple Care and Cleaning instructions, we can quarantee that you will do just that...

The Bambino TiiPii Bed is not designed to be set up outdoors permanently.

It is recommended for use in fair weather only, and should always be ideally paired with its optional waterproof cover (sold separately).

Even when paired with the waterproof cover, leaving the TiiPii Bed set up for a long amount of time outside will greatly reduce the lifespan and look of the TiiPii Bed. If undesired weather is forecast, it is always highly recommended to pack the TiiPii away

COMPLETELY DRY or take it inside.

Although the fabric is treated for mould and UV resistance, failure to thoroughly clean, entirely dry and stow away will compromise the lifespan of your TiiPii greatly, and void warranty

Machine washable.

Cold wash only, preferably on a gentle cycle or inside a wash bag.

Do not tumble dry.

Do not iron.

Do not bleach.

Remove the ring section prior to washing.

Always dry your TiiPii Bed with the ring system fully reinserted and assembled to prevent deformation; this is very important.

Do not allow the TiiPii Bed to come into contact with a vertical surface or any other object that could damage the ring system or cause abrasion to the fabric.

Do not leave in direct sunlight or harsh weather conditions of any kind. A TiiPii should never be subjected to prolonged weather such as excessive sunlight, rain, snow, etc.

Never allow water to gather in the bottom of the TiiPii – as this could not only compromise the integrity of the fabric over time, but also increase the risk of children drowning.

Stow or pack away the TiiPii Bed in periods between use.

Always ensure the TiiPii and / or the waterproof cover is completely 100% dry when packing it away. Any moisture or dampness will result in damage caused by mould.

Clean and care for your TiiPii as advised within these instructions; if mould, mildew or stains are not treated when noticed, you will compromise the appearance and quality of the TiiPii Bed



- Warranty -



Proper maintenance and care will help to prolong the life of the Bambino TiiPii Stand and reduce the potential for injury, product damage or voided warranty.

- What you'll find inside -

l x Central 'Y' shaped base piece
4 x Nut & Bolt sets (for 'Y' base piece)
4 x 'L' shaped steel base poles
4 x 'Lower Section' steel poles (1 end male, 1 end female)
4 x 'Upper Section' steel poles (male end on both sides)
1 x steel 'Crown Piece'
1 x Fillable Stabiliser Sand Bag - *Important*

Minimum space required & Stand dimensions



Minimum height for indoor setup: 2.2m Minimum floor space: Ø 1.6m

-Warning-

Contains small parts that may provide a choking hazard

A Bambino Stand should NEVER be used without the filled Stabiliser Sand Bag – this is an important safety measure to prevent the TiiPii & Stand from potentially tipping over and causing injury

When using the Bambino TiiPii Stand with the Bambino TiiPii Bed, the maximum load limit is 70kgs / 110lbs. Any weight over this will cause the TiiPii Bed to ground on the floor when laden.



Assembling the TiiPii Stand

- 1. Always ensure the Bambino TiiPii Stand is being set up on an even, flat and solid surface this is extremely important otherwise it is at risk of tipping over, even if the filled Stabiliser Sand Bag is in place.
- 2. Place the central 'Y' base piece on the ground in the middle of your intended position.
- 3. Lay out the 4 'L' shaped base poles so they individually align with the 4 end points of the 'Y' base piece.
- 4. Remove the nuts and bolts from the 'Y' section. Feed 1 through each hole in the 'L' base poles. *NB, the other end of each 'L' base pole should be pointing upwards when attaching.
- 5. Tighten nuts & bolts so they fasten the 'Y' piece to the 'L' base poles together securely.
- 6. Grab the 4 'Lower Section' poles. (Lower Section poles have a male connector on one end only)
- 7. With the male end of the 'Lower Section' pole, attach the 'Lower Section' to each of the uprights on the 'L' base poles.
- 8. Grab your 'Upper Section' poles (Upper Section poles have male connectors on both ends of each pole)
- 9. Attach each 'Upper Section' pole to a 'Lower Section' pole.
- 10. Check that all sections are joined and connected together evenly across the Stand.
- 11. Attach the final 'Crown Piece' to the 4 remaining 'Upper Section' poles, ensuring all 4 sections are secured together properly.

12. Warning! Never use the Stand without the Stabiliser Sand Bag for safety.

- 13. Fill the Stabiliser Sand Bag entirely with sand so it is at full capacity when zipped closed to ensure maximum weight for anchoring the stand base is achieved.
- 14. Place directly in the centre of the fully assembled Bambino Stand on top of the 'Y' iunction.
- 15. Check that there is no movement or ability to unbalance easily before each and every use. This is an extremely important safety measure and should not be ignored.
- 17. Never use the Bambino Stand without the fully filled Stabiliser Sand Bag in place to avoid injury in or around the TiiPii Bed as it can tip over. Never leave children unattended and never allow them to remove the Stabiliser Sand Bag that secures the Bambino Stand at any time.



-TiiPii Safety-

Please read & complete these safety checks every time before use to avoid hazard and / or injury:

- 1. No TiiPii products are intended for use by children under the age of 3 years.
- 2. Children over the ages of **3+** are to be under direct adult supervision at all times. Never leave a child of any age unattended.
- 3. Never exceed the maximum load limit for the Bambino Stand of 70kgs / 110lbs / 11st.
- 4. Never use the Bambino Stand without the Stabiliser Sand Bag, fully filled, in place. Check that there is no movement or ability to unbalance easily once secured before each and every use- this is a very important safety measure!
- 5. Ensure each individual pole, base and crown section is attached securely, with every piece inserted fully and correctly before each use. Check the nut & bolt sets have firmly attached the central base piece to the base legs.
- 6. Always ensure the stand is positioned on a dry, flat, firm & horizontal surface only.
- 7. Do not attempt to setup or use the Bambino Stand on sloping, uneven or soft ground.
- 8. Never use or leave any TiiPii products set up in undesired weather. Do not use, assemble or leave set up in high winds. Disassemble & pack away in advance of any storms or high winds that are forecast. Failure to do so could result in serious damage or injury.
- 9. Never to be used as a climbing apparatus or toy. This Bambino Stand is not to be used for any other purpose not expressly intended by the manufacturer.
- 10. Do not use if the Bambino Stand has become damaged or the metal has been compromised in a way that would impair safe and proper use.
- 11. Refer to the 'Bambino TiiPii Bed Instructions & Safety' manual included with purchase of the TiiPii Bed (sold separately) before using the TiiPii Bed.

The Bambino TiiPii Stand is not designed to be set up outdoors permanently.

It is recommended for use in fair weather, and any scratches, dints or damages to the powder coating should be resealed immediately with an appropriate metal paint to avoid rust and erosion.

Wherever possible, dry the Bambino Stand when wet and limit exposure to rain, as water may cause unseen surface rust from inside of the stand poles to run down the external surface and stain.

Leaving the Bambino TiiPii Stand set up for long amounts of time outside could reduce the look of the Bambino Stand greatly. During seasons that it will not be used, simply pack it away, ensuring it is always COMPLETELY DRY to avoid damage to the steel and powder coating...

Do not allow the TiiPii Stand to come into contact with another surface or object that could damage the strength of the stand or the integrity of the powder coating.

Clean and care for your TiiPii Stand as advised within these instructions; if rust, dampness and scratches are not treated when noticed, the appearance and quality of the TiiPii Stand will become compromised.

If enjoyed outside, ensure that all elements of the Bambino Stand are completely dry, inside and out, before placing indoors to avoid water marks on carpet or internal flooring.
