Getting started

Thank you for purchasing this John Lewis & Partners product. For your safety, and to make sure everything is working properly, please read the instructions carefully before use.

Warnings

This is a Class II product and must NOT be earthed.

It is recommended that this fitting is installed by a qualified electrician. Install in accordance with the IEE Wiring regulations and the Building Regulations. To prevent electrocution switch off at mains supply before installing or maintaining this fitting. Ensure other persons cannot restore the electrical supply without your knowledge. If you are in any doubt, please consult a qualified electrician.

This light fitting should be connected to a 5 amp fused circuit.

If replacing an existing fitting, make a note of the connections.

Always use the correct type and wattage bulb. Never exceed the wattage stated. Dispose of used bulbs carefully.

This product is suitable for installation on surfaces with normal flammability e.g. wood, plasterboard, masonry. It is not suitable for use on highly flammable surfaces (e.g. polystyrene, textiles).

For your safety, always switch off the supply and allow the fitting to cool down before changing lightbulbs, cleaning or removing shades.

Note:

During transit, the cables can become kinked. It may be necessary to straighten the cables to allow the shades to hang level. Manipulate the kinked cables between thumb and fingers to straighten.

Product assembly

Step 1

Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly. Before removing the existing fitting, carefully note the position of each set of wires.

Step 2

Remove the fixing bracket (A) from the product by loosening the four side screws (B).

Ensure there is a solid mounting surface to support the weight of the light fitting. Using the fixing bracket as a template, mark the position of the mounting holes. Drill holes and fit supplied wall plugs (C) (suitable for masonry only). Take care to avoid damaging any concealed wiring and pipes. Fix the bracket to the ceiling using supplied screws (D).


Step 3


The hanging height of this product can be adjusted. Work out the required height and feed the cables through the cord grips (E) until the desired height is achieved. It maybe necessary to cut, shorten and reconnect the cables. If you are unsure how to do this, contact a qualified electrician.

Step 4

Having identified the household wiring from your existing light fitting, connect to the connection block (F) inside the product in the following way. Check that: You have correctly identified the house wires. The connections are tight.

No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.





Step 5

Refit the product to the fixing bracket. This product has "L" shaped fixing holes to allow easy fixing to the fixing bracket. Locate the "L" slots (G) around the side screws (B) on fixing bracket (A). Slide the ceiling cover to attach the product to the bracket. Tighten the screws to secure. Take care not to trap any wiring.

Step 6

To fit the shades (H), first remove the shade rings (I) from the threaded lampholders. Place the shades over the lampholders and refit the shade rings. Secure in place.

Step 7

Fit the recommended bulbs () as per the details overleaf.

Step 8

Replace fuse or circuit breaker and switch on. Your light is now ready for use.
