# Product assembly

#### Step 1

Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly and place on a stable, flat surface.

## Step 2

Screw tube (B) onto the lampholder section (A) in a clockwise direction. Take care not to trap the cable or cross the threads. Turn tube (C) anticlockwise approximately 6 times. (Turning the tubes anticlockwise first ensures that the cable will straighten when the tubes are fully assembled).

## Step 3

Gently pull any excess cable through the side of tube (C). Then screw tube (C) onto tube (B) in the same way.

**Note:** If you find it difficult to assemble tubes (C) and (B), the cable might be twisted. Please ensure to follow steps 2 and 3 closely.

#### Step 4

Screw the base (D) onto the stem and stand the product upright. Check the tightness of the joints.

## Step 5

To attach the shade (E), first remove the shade ring (F) from the threaded lampholder. Place the shade over the lampholder and refit the shade ring. Tighten to secure. Take care not to loosen the lower lampholder ring.

## Step 6

Ft the recommended bulb (G) as per the details overleaf.

## Step 7

Unbundle the cable from the cable tie. Your floor lamp is now ready to use. Turn on using the switch on the lampholder (H).

## Note:

The shade and arm position can be adjusted by partially loosening the thumb screws in the joints of the arm (I).

If the shade is not facing forward. Partially loosen the thumb screws and flip the arm as shown if fig. 1. Avoid fully undoing the adjustable joints.
