

PORCINI TABLE LAMP INFORMATION LEAFLET

Thank you for purchasing this table lamp. Please read the enclosed information carefully before use to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

Warnings

This product is only suitable for connection to a 240V~50Hz supply in accordance with current IEE Wiring Regulations. It is for indoor use only, and not suitable for a Bathroom location.

This is a Class II product and must NOT be earthed.

Do not plug into the mains until your lamp is fully assembled. It must be used on a stable, flat surface.

Under no circumstances must this table lamp be covered with any material as this could pose a safety hazard.

Caution: This product is heavy. When manoeuvring or assembling it must be lifted from the bottom section.

The lamp must be protected by a 3 amp fuse in the mains plug.

If you are in any doubt, please consult a qualified electrician.

For your safety, always switch off the power supply before cleaning or changing the bulb.

If the mains cable becomes damaged it must only be replaced by a technically competent, qualified person to avoid a hazard.

Ensure cables do not present a trip hazard or strangulation hazard.

Always use correct type and wattage bulb. Never exceed the wattage stated.

Product assembly

Step 1

Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly.

Step 2

Fit the recommended bulbs (A). 2 x Max. 6W LED E14 Golf.

Step 3

To attach the shade (B), first remove the finial and rubber washer (C) from the top of the stem. Place the shade over the product and refit the rubber washer and finial. Tighten with light pressure to secure the shade.

Step 4

Plug in and switch on. Your table lamp is now ready for use.
