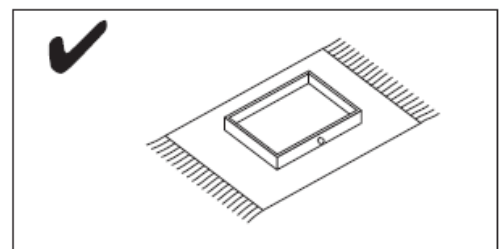
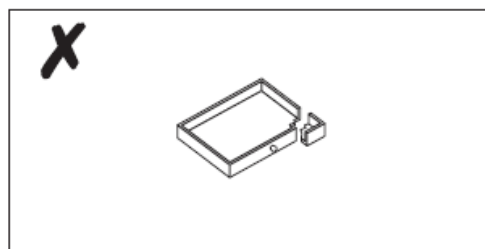
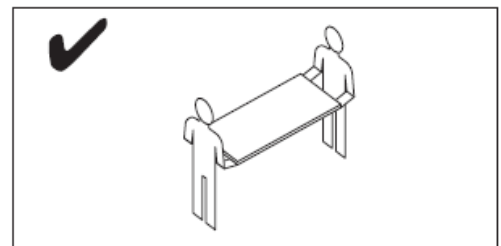
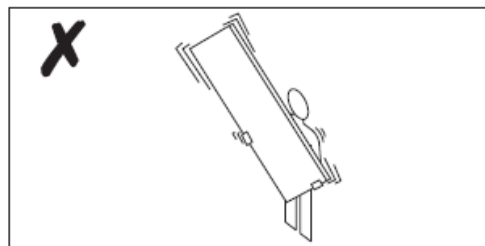
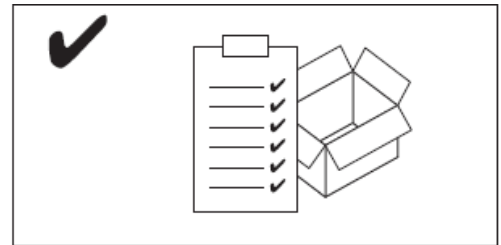
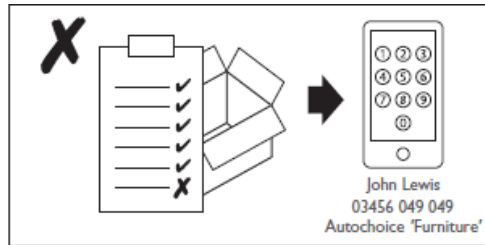
- △ The product is HEAVY; it should only be assembled near point of use.
- △ Keep small parts out of reach of children.
- △ Ensure the product is fully assembled as illustrated before use.
- △ Parasol should not be used in high winds or during inclement weather.
- △ This parasol must always be weighted with a suitable base weighing a minimum of 15 kg, even when closed.
- △ When not in use, the parasol canopy should be closed and securely tied.
- △ It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely dis-assembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.

Do's





- ✓ Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed.
- ✓ Check all screws or bolts are tightened and inspect regularly.
- ✓ Make sure the base remains in contact with the ground at all times.






Don'ts

- ✓ **X** Do not stand on the product.
- ✓ **X** Do not over tighten screws or bolts.
- ✓ **X** Do not over tighten the crank as this can damage the mechanism.
- ✓ **X** Do not use power tools to construct as over tightening and panel failure may occur.

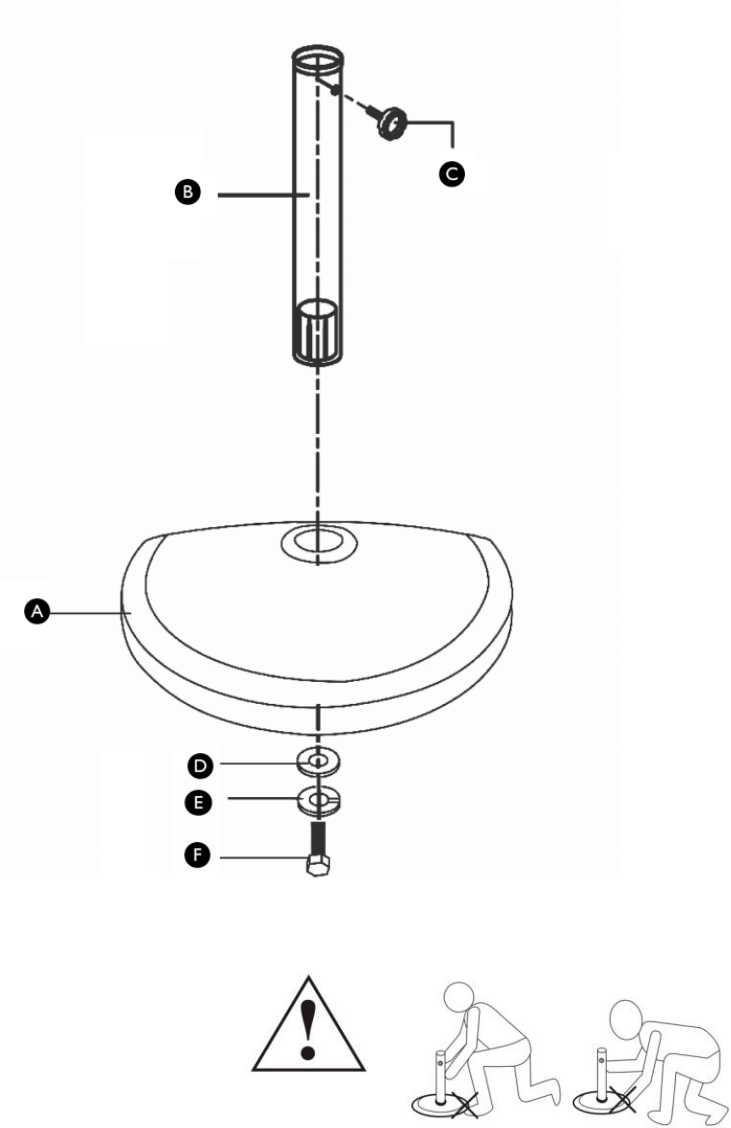

Care and maintenance

- This base is made from resin and is suitable for outdoor use.
- The parasol is made from powder coated aluminium and polyester and is suitable for outdoor use
- We recommend that you clean your base at the beginning and end of the season.
- To clean, remove all dirt using mild soap and water. Never use abrasive chemicals or cleaning agents. Rinse thoroughly and allow to dry. Bird droppings and tree sap should be cleaned off immediately.
- To extend the product life and appearance it is recommended to store the parasol and base in a cool dry, well-ventilated place such as a garage or shed over winter or during periods of unseasonal weather.
- Ensure that the parasol is clean and completely dry before putting in to storage. Do not enclose the product in a plastic or other non-permeable material as this promotes rust. Cover it with a dust sheet or furniture cover allowing the air to circulate around it.
- Don't stand or jump on base.
- In high winds we recommend taking umbrella down to avoid it tipping over.
- Do not drop the base as this may cause the product to shatter.
- Do not over-tighten the crank as this can damage the mechanism.

Safety

- This parasol and base have been designed for domestic use only.
- Parasol bases can be dangerous if incorrectly installed or assembled, it should be carried out by a competent person.
- No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled parasol bases.
- Parasols should not be used in high winds or during inclement weather.
- This parasol base must always be filled to the top.
- Never drag a parasol base when moving it, always lift it.
- Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.
- Ensure that the parasol base is always on a solid and level surface at all times.
