
- ✓ Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed.

- ✓ Make sure the legs remain in contact with the ground at all times.




- X Do not over tighten screws or bolts.

- X Do not use power tools to construct as overtightening and panel failure may occur.








How to care for your wood furniture

Place the product in a location with less direct sunlight, preferably under shade or parasol.

Regularly wipe and clean the furniture using a soft damp cloth.

Dilute dishwashing liquid in water to clean any stains and buff to dry.

The wood care maintenance guide is for reference only. It is recommended to follow the application guide provided by varnish/oil manufacturers. In order to maintain the appearance of the wood, regular coating of oil must be applied. The frequency will depend on the weather conditions experienced.

- 1. Oil is best applied with a clean cloth. Simply wipe the oil onto the wood surface straight from the container.
- 2. Treat all surfaces of the furniture. Please ensure that any hidden surfaces (sush as those exposed when the furniture in turned upside down) are also treated. Particular care should be given to the end grain and any joints or crevices.
- 3. Let the surface dry out. This can take 4 to 12 hours but depends on the surrounding conditions.
- 4. Repeat step 2 & 3 with at least 2 more coats of oil. Extra coats will give semi gloss sheen once the oil has dried out. Any excess oil can by wiped off with a clean cloth. Please follow the application guide provided by varnish / oil manufacturers.

Safety instructions

This furniture has been designed for domestic use only.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed or assembled, it should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.

It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely disassembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.

Please take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury.

Ensure that the furniture is always on a solid and level surface at all times.

With all articulated furniture, please exercise care when folding, unfolding and adjusting position s to avoid any possibility of pinched or trapped fingers.

Retain these instructions for future reference.
