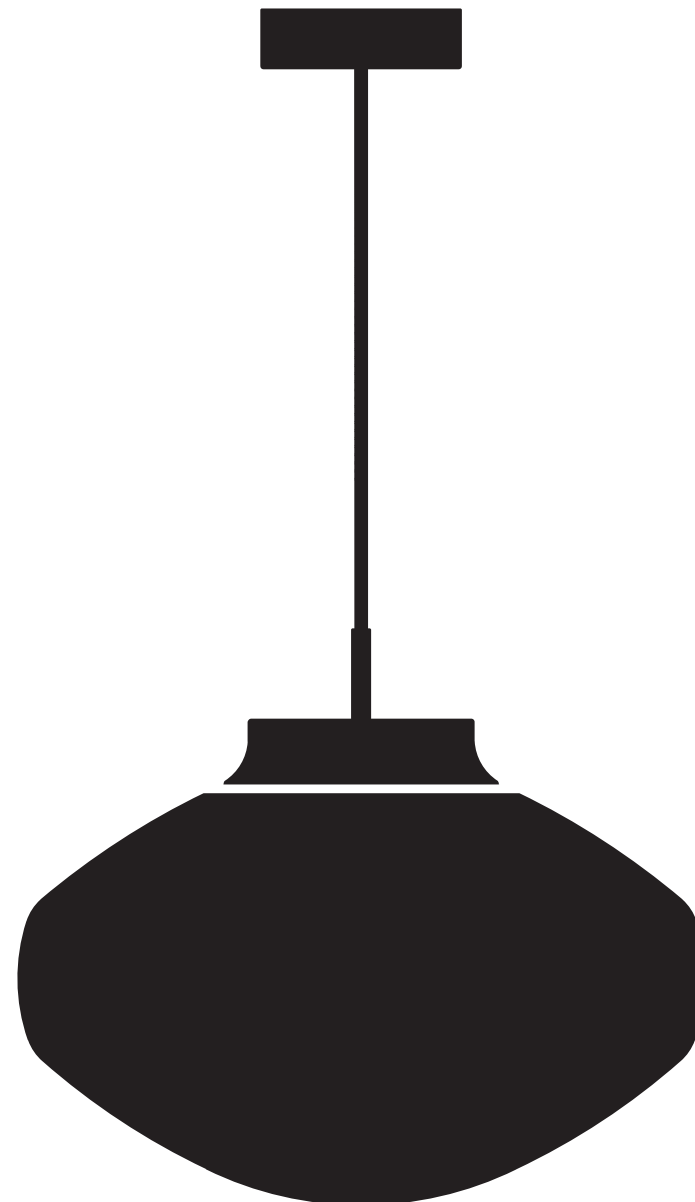

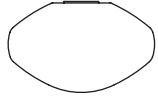
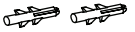
TEMPLE PENDANT USER GUIDE

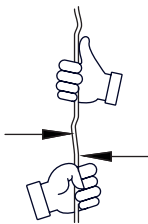

Getting started Thank you for purchasing this John Lewis & Partners product. For your safety, and to make sure everything is working properly, please read the instructions carefully before use.

Warnings This is a Class II product and must NOT be earthed. It is recommended that this fitting is installed by a qualified electrician. Install in accordance with the IEE Wiring regulations and the Building Regulations. To prevent electrocution switch off at mains supply before installing or maintaining this fitting. Ensure other persons cannot restore the electrical supply without your knowledge. If you are in any doubt, please consult a qualified electrician. This light fitting should be connected to a 5 Amp fused circuit. If replacing an existing fitting, make a note of the connections. Always use the correct type and wattage bulb. Never exceed the wattage stated. Dispose of used bulbs carefully. This product is suitable for installation on surfaces with normal flammability e.g. wood, plasterboard, masonry. It is not suitable for use on highly flammable surfaces (e.g. polystyrene, textiles). This product contains glass so care must be taken when fitting or handling to prevent personal injury or damage to the product. For your safety, always switch off the supply and allow the fitting to cool down before changing the lightbulb, cleaning or removing the shade. **Please note:** This product contains wood which is a natural material. The variations in veining, colour and texture are natural characteristics which make each piece unique.

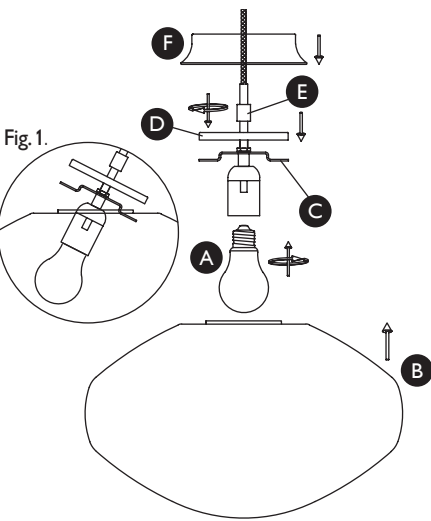
Note: During transit, the cable can become kinked. It may be necessary to straighten the cable to allow the shade to hang level. Manipulate the kinked cable between thumb and fingers to straighten.

Product assembly

Step 1 Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly. Before removing the existing fitting, carefully note the position of each set of wires.

Step 2 Fit the recommended bulb (A) as per the details overleaf.

Step 3 Fitting the glass shade (B) may be easier before attaching the product to the ceiling. Loosen collar (E) and lift topper (D). Tilt the bracket on the top of the lampholder (C) and insert inside the shade. See Fig. 1. Locate the shade on the bracket ensuring it is correctly located on both sides of the bracket. Allow the shade topper to rest on top of the shade and secure in place by tightening the collar. Do not overtighten. Pull the wood trim (F) down the cable and rest on top of the shade.



Step 4 Remove the fixing bracket (G) from the product by unscrewing the two side screws (H) and retain for reuse. Ensure there is a solid mounting surface to support the weight of the light fitting. Using the fixing bracket as a template, mark the position of the mounting holes. Drill holes and fit supplied wall plugs (I) (suitable for masonry only). Take care to avoid damaging any concealed wiring and pipes. Fix the bracket to the ceiling using supplied screws (J).

Step 5 The hanging height of this product can be adjusted. Feed the cable through the cord grip (K) until the desired height is achieved. **Please note:** Do not loosen the cable clamp screw inside the ceiling cup as this is securing the cable into the terminal block.

Step 6 Having identified the household wiring from your existing light fitting, connect the house wiring to the connection block (L). Connect Live cable to terminal marked 'L' and Neutral cable to terminal marked 'N'. **NOTE: This is a Class II fitting and must NOT be connected to earth. Check that...**

You have correctly identified the house wires. The connections are tight. No loose strands have been left out of the connection block. Make sure the lid of the connection box is securely fixed.

Step 7 Reattach the product to the fixing bracket using the two screws removed in step 4 and tighten to secure. Take care not to trap any wiring. Your light is now ready for use.
