# **Assembly**

Refer to assembly drawing opposite. Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly.

#### Step 1

Do not attempt to plug in or use this product until it has been fully assembled. Disconnect from mains during assembly or maintenance.

#### Step 2

Remove all packaging from the base, the central tubes and shade. Remove any cable protection pieces in the ends of the tubes.

## Step 3

Locate tubes A and B into the sockets on the shade. Secure the shade in place by tightening the screws using the supplied hex key. Do not overtighten.

#### Step 4

Screw Tubes C and D on to the central panel in a clockwise direction. Take care not to trap the cable or cross the thread.

## Step 5

Locate the end of Tubes C and D on to the base. Gently pull any excess cable through from Tube D under the base. Fit the washers and nuts onto the threads and securely tighten using the supplied spanner.

## Step 6

Stand the product upright and check the tightness of the joints.

#### Step 7

Your standard lamp is now ready to use. Attach the power cable to the plug and plug in to the mains supply. Switch on with the switch on the central panel.
