YARN

Brushed Fleece

NEEDLES

1 pair 5mm (no 6) (US 8) needles 1 pair 5½mm (no 5) (US 9) needles 4½mm (no 7) (US 7) circular needle 5mm (no 6) (US 8) circular needle 5½mm (no 5) (US 9) circular needle

TENSION

14 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 5½mm (US 9) needles.

BACK and FRONT (both alike)

Using 5mm (US 8) needles cast on 70 [76: 84: 90: 98: 104] sts. Work in g st for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Change to 5½mm (US 9) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st throughout as folls:

Cont straight until work meas 41.5 [42: 42.5: 43: 43.5: 44] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape raglan armholes

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 64 [70: 78: 84: 92: 98] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [3: 7: 9: 13: 15] rows, then on foll 13 alt rows. 36 [38: 38: 40: 40: 42] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder (for collar).

SLEEVES

Using 5mm (US 8) needles cast on 28 [28: 30: 30: 30: 32] sts.

Row 1 (RS): P1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 1], K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last

1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 1] st, P1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 1].

Row 2: K1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 1], P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 1] st, K1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 1].

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib until sleeve meas 15 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 5½mm (US 9) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st throughout as folls:

Inc 1 st at each end of 3rd [3rd: next: next: next: next] and every foll 4th [4th: alt: alt: alt: alt] row to 50 [54: 34: 36: 44: 46] sts, then on every foll 6th [-: 4th: 4th: 4th: 4th] row until there are 52 [54: 58: 60: 64: 66] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 45 [46: 46: 47: 47: 47] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 46 [48: 52: 54: 58: 60] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and 3 foll 4th rows, then on every foll alt row until 24 sts rem.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder (for collar).

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join all raglan armhole seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Collar

With RS facing and using 4½mm (US 7) circular needle, K across 24 sts on left sleeve holder, 36 [38: 38: 40: 40: 42] sts on front holder, 24 sts on right sleeve holder, then 36 [38: 38: 40: 40: 42] sts on back holder.

120 [124: 124: 128: 128: 132] sts.

Turn work, so that next round will be worked with **WS** of body facing – this becomes RS of collar.

Round 1 (RS of collar, WS of body): *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep last round 3 times more, dec 0 [4: 4: 3: 3: 2] sts evenly around last round. 120 [120: 120: 125: 125: 130] sts.

Change to 5mm (US 8) circular needle.

Round 5: Knit.

Rep last round 5 times more.

Round 11: (K2, inc in next st, K2) 24 [24: 24: 25: 25: 26] times.

144 [144: 144: 150: 150: 156] sts.


Change to 5½mm (US 9) circular needle.


Now rep round 5 until collar meas 16 cm from pick-up round.



Cast off loosely.
