



## Warnings!

This is a Class 1 product and must be earthed.

For your safety, this product must be installed in accordance with local Building Regulations. If in any doubt, or where required by the law, consult a competent person who is registered with an electrical self-declaration scheme. Further information is available online or from your Local Authority

To prevent electric shock switch off at mains supply before installing or maintaining this fitting. Ensure other persons cannot restore the electrical supply without your knowledge.

This light fitting should be connected to a 5 amp fused circuit.

This product is suitable for installation on surfaces with normal flammability e.g. wood, plasterboard, masonry. It is not suitable for use on highly flammable surfaces (e.g. polystyrene, textiles).


Ensure the correct fixings are used for the installation surface.

For your safety, always switch off the supply before cleaning or adjusting.

**This product is dimmable when used in conjunction with suitable bulbs.**

**GU10 LED bulbs up to 7W can be used - but ensure that the minimum distance to**

**the illuminated surface is not less than 0.5m (50 cm). Ensure spotlights do not face each other.**

## Assembly

Refer to assembly drawing opposite. Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly.


## Step 1

This product will be easier to install with the help of an assistant. This product has been designed with folding bars to allow different configurations and layouts to be easily achieved. To position the bars, fold them out into the desired configuration. There is no need to tighten the bars once in position. They are designed to rotate freely to allow easy operation. When installing and using this product, take care not to allow the bars and heads to collide with each other.

Before removing the existing fitting, **carefully note the position of each set of wires.**

## Step 2

Having identified the household wiring from your existing light fitting, connect to the connection block inside the product as shown. When completed, ensure that there are no bare or loose strands of wire exposed, and cover all exposed areas of the connection block with 2 layers of insulation tape.




## Check that

You have correctly identified the house wires.

The connections are tight.

No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.



## Step 4

Fit the bulbs per the details overleaf, using the tool provided.

## Step 5

Replace fuse or circuit breaker and switch on. Your light is now ready for use.

## Step 3

See Fig 1. Locate the fixing screws through the white plastic plugs in the ceiling cover and screw directly into the ceiling making sure that there is a joist at the point of fixing. Take care not to trap or damage any wiring. Apply the chrome finish screw caps to the screw heads once attached to the ceiling.
