

# Harry Floor Lamp User Guide





#### Getting started

Thank you for purchasing this John Lewis & Partners product. For your safety, and to make sure everything is working properly, please read the instructions carefully before use.

### Warnings

This is a Class II product and must NOT be earthed.

Please read these instructions carefully before commencing any work. Your lamp has been packaged as separate parts to prevent damage during transit. When manoeuvring or assembling this product, it must be lifted from the bottom section.

The lamp must be protected by a 3 amp fuse in the mains plug. If you are in any doubt, please consult a qualified electrician. For your safety, always switch off the supply before cleaning or changing the bulb. If the mains cable becomes damaged it must only be replaced by a technically competent, qualified person.

Always use correct type and wattage bulb. Never exceed the wattage stated.

### Product assembly

#### Step 1

Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly.


Remove protective plastic end-caps from the tubes.

Screw tube (B) onto tube (A) in a clockwise direction. Then screw tube (C) onto tube (B), tube (D) onto tube (C) and tube (E) onto tube (D) in the same way. Take care not to trap the cable or cross the thread.

Gently pull any excess cable through from under the base (F) and then out through the side of the base. Turn the completed assembly anticlockwise approximately 6 times (Turning the tubes anticlockwise first ensures that the cable will straighten when the tubes are fully assembled). Screw the assembly in a clockwise direction on to the base.

Secure using the grub screws and Allen key (G).

Stand the product upright and check the tightness of the joints by hand.



#### Step 3

Remove the shade ring (H) from the lampholder, place the shade (I) over the lampholder and refit the shade ring. Tighten to secure the shade in place.

Fit the bulb (J). Do not exceed the recommended rated power as this may cause damage to the light fitting.

Unbundle the cable from the cable tie. Your floor lamp is now ready to use. Switch on using the floor switch.
