



Paint your own tea set


Thank you for purchasing this set.
This must be used under adult supervision.
Please read the instructions and warnings
carefully before use.

Before you start Always protect clothing and work area during use. Line your work surface with newspaper before you start painting.

Painting the pottery Wipe the pieces clean before you start painting using the coloured paints provided.
Clean the paintbrush between colours and thoroughly after use.
Add a few drops of water to the paint if it appears too dry or sticky.
Always replace the paint pot lids when not in use.
Before painting dries, you can wipe off any mistakes with a tissue or wash off. Corrections can't be made once pottery is baked.
Dry the pottery for 24 hours after you have finished painting.

Baking the pottery To be completed by an adult.
Use a normal gas or electric oven, NOT Microwave.
Place pottery on a suitable baking tray and bake at 100 °C / 212 °F for 25 minutes.
Let the pottery cool in the oven after baking, as it will be very hot.
Allow to cool completely before handling.

Care instructions Pottery is hand wash only, NOT dishwasher safe.

Warning!  Not suitable for children under 3 years.
Small parts - Choking hazard.
Small pieces of clay may present a choking hazard.
For use by children over 6 years of age.
For use under adult supervision.
May stain, always protect clothing and work areas.
Play tea set only. Not suitable for hot or cold drinks.
Remove all packaging and tags before giving to a child.
