
#### Product assembly




NOTE: When assembling, keep in mind that this arc lamp should face forward with the cord coming out of the back of the base. The screw hole of tube (B) should face towards the back of the lamp in the same direction as the cord coming out of the back of the base.



- Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all parts are included before assembly. Place lamp parts on a flat surface when assembling.
- 2. Place tube (A) onto tube (B) and screw to tighten.




3. Insert tube (C), (D) and (E) into tube (B). Then, turn part (D) on each tube until tight to connect the arms. To easily assemble each joint together, make sure to slightly lift up the arm to relieve the pressure. This will allow for the joints to easily screw together.




4. Insert pole (A) into washer (G) and base (H). Tighten nut (I) to washer (I) and base (H) using wrench (K).

5. Place shades (L) onto socket holders (N). Screw socket rings (M) on until tight to secure shade.

**NOTE**: The Arc lamp should face forward with the cord coming out of the back of the base and you may need to pull any excess cord through the pole to base.
