



Getting started

Thank you for purchasing this John Lewis & Partners product. For your safety, and to make sure everything is working properly, please read the instructions carefully before use.

Warnings

This is a Class 1 product and must be earthed. It is recommended that this fitting is installed by a qualified electrician. Install in accordance with the IEE Wiring regulations and the Building Regulations. To prevent electrocution switch off at mains supply before installing or maintaining this fitting. Ensure other persons cannot restore the electrical supply without your knowledge. If you are in any doubt, please consult a qualified electrician. This light fitting should be connected to a 5 amp fused circuit. If replacing an existing fitting, make a note of the connections. Always use the correct type and wattage bulb. Never exceed the wattage stated. Dispose of used bulbs carefully. This product is suitable for indoor use only. This product is suitable for installation on surfaces with normal flammability e.g. wood, plasterboard, masonry. It is not suitable for use on highly flammable surfaces (e.g. polystyrene, textiles). For your safety, always switch off the supply and allow to cool down before changing lightbulbs, cleaning or removing shades.

Product assembly

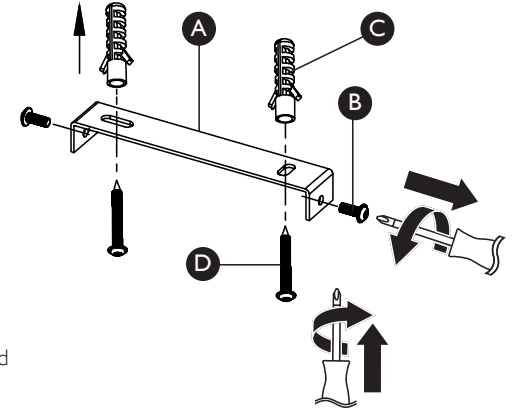
Step 1

Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly. Before removing the existing fitting, carefully note the position of each set of wires.

Step 2

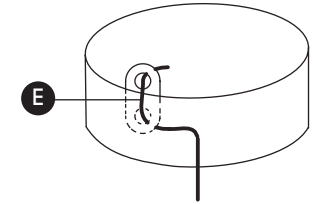
Remove the fixing bracket (A) from the product by unscrewing the two side screws (B) and retain for reuse. Ensure there is a solid mounting surface to support the weight of the light fitting. Using the fixing bracket as a template, mark the position of the mounting holes. Drill holes and fit supplied wall plugs (C) (suitable for masonry only). Take care to avoid damaging any concealed wiring and pipes.

Fix the bracket to the ceiling using supplied screws (D).



Step 3

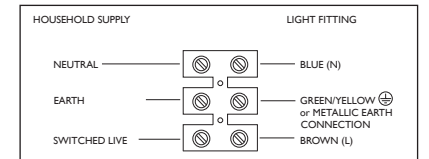
The hanging height of this product can be adjusted. Work out the required height and feed the cable through the cord grip (E) until the desired height is achieved.



Please note: Do not loosen the screw clamp inside the ceiling cup, as this is securing the cable into the terminal block.

Step 4

Connect the product to the household wiring. Check that: You have correctly identified the house wires. The connections are tight. No loose strands have been left out of the connection block. When completed, ensure that there are no bare or loose strands of wire exposed.



Step 5

Re-attach the product to the fixing bracket and tighten the side screws. This product has "L" shaped fixing holes to allow easy fixing to the fixing bracket. Locate the "L" slots around the side screws (B) on fixing bracket (A). Rotate the ceiling cover to attach the product to the bracket. Tighten the screws to secure. Take care not to trap any wiring.

To fit the shade (F), first remove the shade ring (G) from the threaded lampholder. Place the shade over the lampholder and refit the shade ring. Secure in place.

Fit the recommended bulb (H).

Turn on the power and test.
