Do's

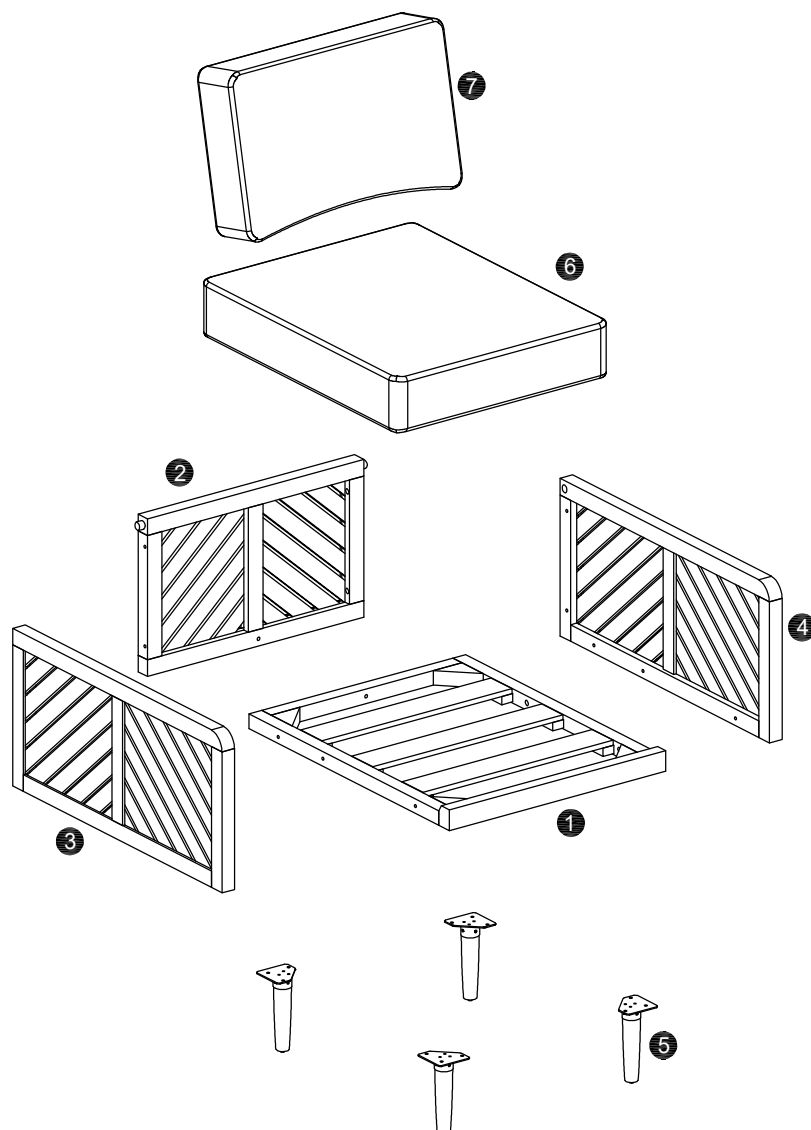
- ✓ Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed.

- ✗ Do not use power tools to construct as overtightening and panel failure may occur.

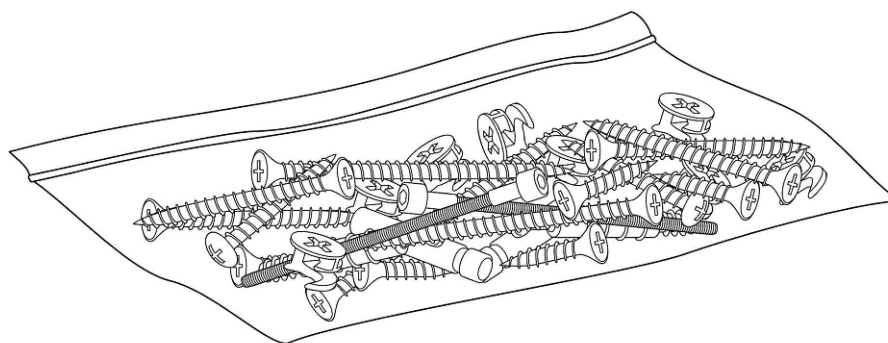

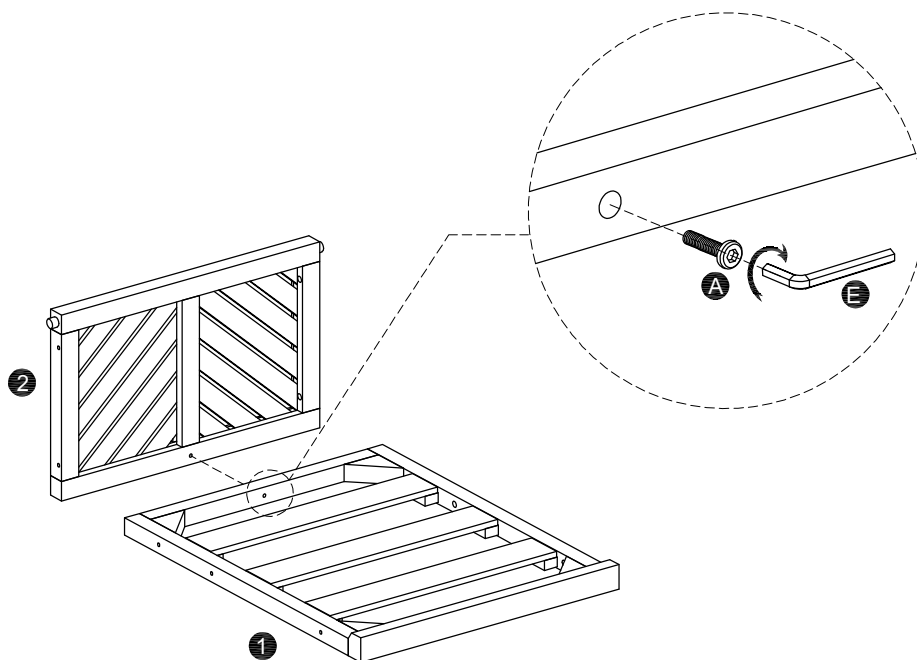
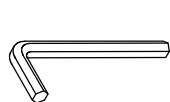

Step 1

Parts, fittings and tools

1 2 A E

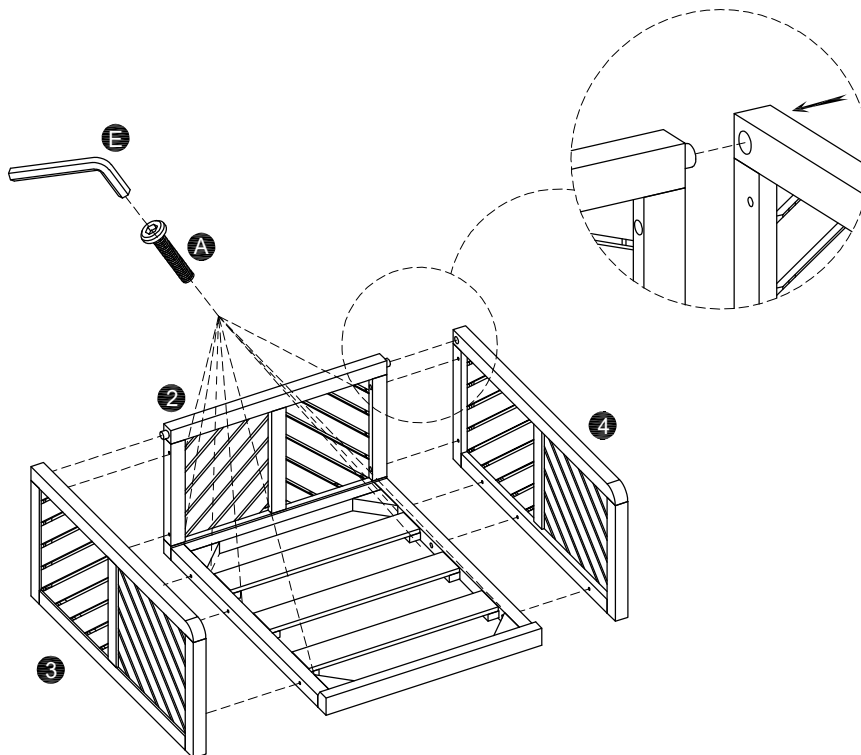


Find a clear area for assembly, near where you intended to use the armchair. Place bottom panel (1) on a soft surface and align with back panel (2). For each hole, insert Large allen bolt (A) and tightening with the Allen key (E) provided.

Step 2

Parts, fittings and tools

3 4 A E



Attach the left side panel (3) and right side panel (4) by inserting the tenon located on either side of the back panel (2). For the remaining holes, insert Large allen bolt (A) and tightening with the Allen key (E) provided.

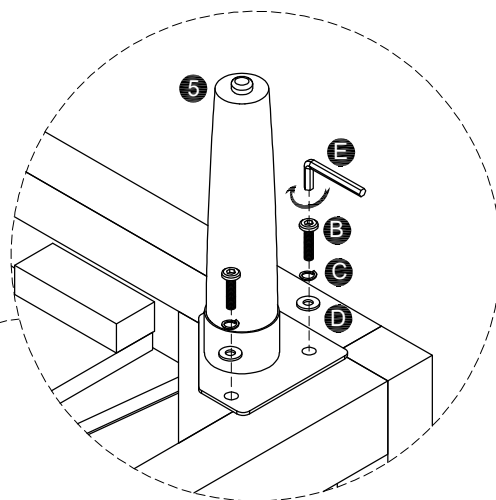
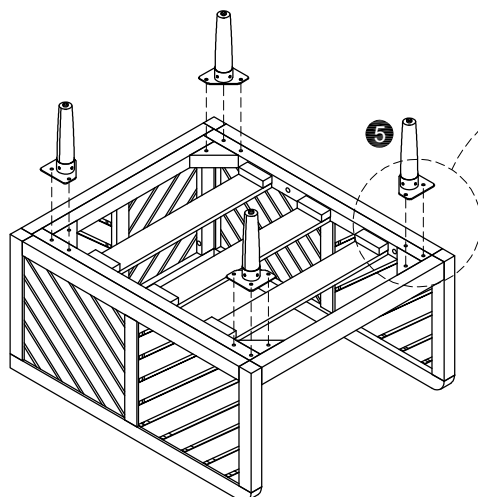
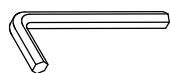

Carefully turn over the sofa to access the underside of the bottom panel. Locate the legs (5) and middle leg (6) and secure using the Small allen bolt (B), Lock washer (C), Washer (D) tightening with the Allen key (E) provided.

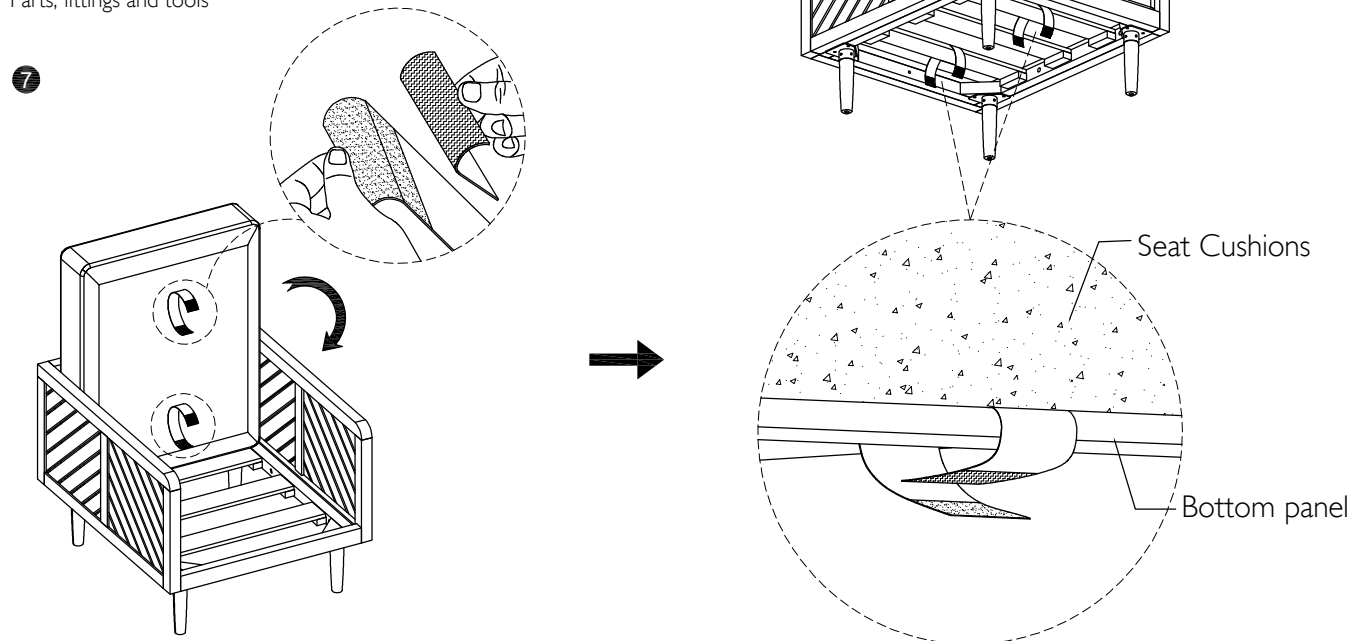
Carefully place the armchair on its feet. Take care when lifting not to damage the legs.

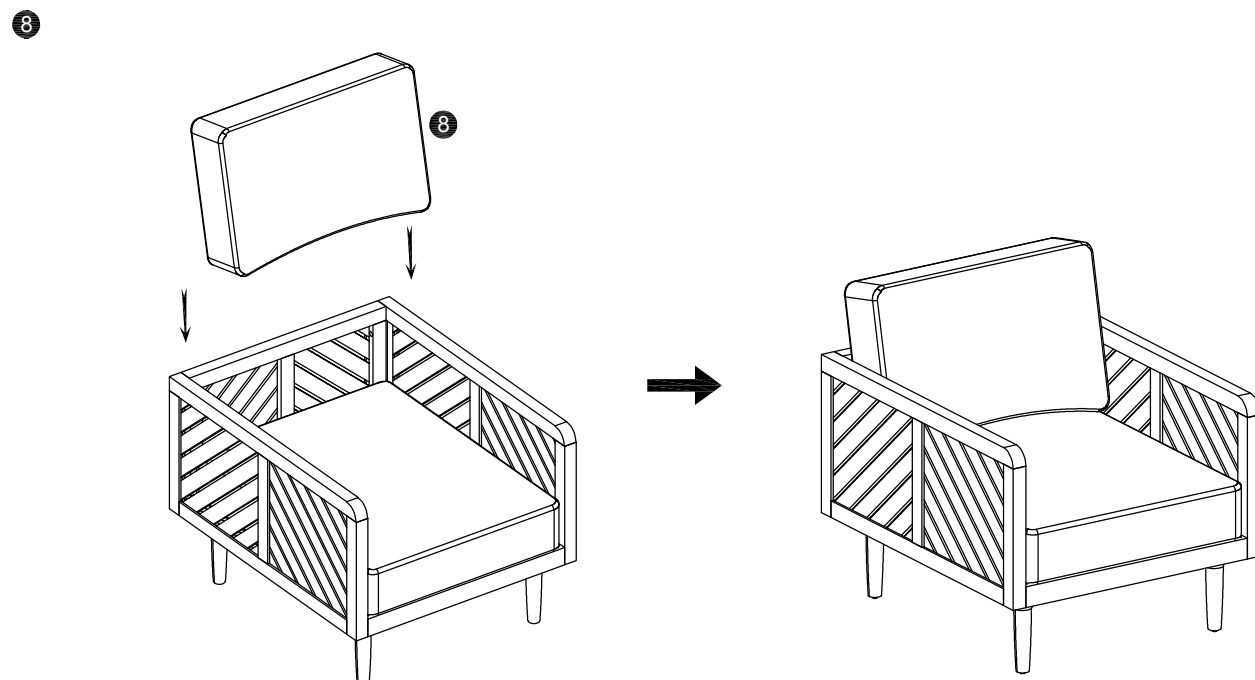

To secure the seat cushions (7) to the frame, peel the velcro straps apart, loop around the corresponding slat on the bottom panel and stick the velcro back together again as shown above.

Place the Back cushions (8) on the armchair.

Care and maintenance

How to care for your outdoor wooden furniture

Your furniture is made from solid FSC Acacia with a hand-applied oil finish. This oil finish helps maintain the appearance of your furniture and helps reduce the effects of weathering. To help maintain the furniture's appearance, we recommend that you re-finish your furniture each year. This can be done by lightly scrubbing with a brush, warm water and a small amount of washing-up liquid, waiting for the furniture to completely dry, then re-apply a branded outdoor furniture oil with a cloth and allowing it to dry.

Wash your outdoor furniture annually, scrub with soapy water followed by a thorough rinse. Do not use a power washer, it will damage the wood.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.

Wood is a natural material, it will expand and contract under different weather conditions causing small fractures to develop along the grain. This is not a fault and adds to the character and beauty of the product.

We recommend that all garden furniture is covered when not in use and stored for winter. Ensure your furniture is clean and completely dry before being covered. The cover must be breathable to prevent mildew and/or mould developing. If storing away, ensure the space is not heated but dry with good airflow.

How to care for your outdoor cushions

To keep outdoor cushions in the best possible condition, we recommend keeping them covered when not in use and/or in wet conditions (using a breathable cover) and store them inside over winter. Do not store in polythene bags or they may develop mould.

To clean the cushions, remove the covers and gently spot clean using upholstery shampoo or warm soapy water (with a mild detergent) to blot out any stains as soon as they occur.

Retain these instructions for future reference.
